

Declaration of data protection

Scope

This privacy policy is intended to inform the users of this website in accordance with the Federal Data Protection Act and the Telemedia Act on the type, scope and purpose of the collection and use of personal data by the website operator Munich LAD's – Lucky Afternoon Dancers e.V., c/o Kurt Fluger, Valleyst. 54a, 81371 München.

The website operator takes your privacy very seriously and will treat your personal information confidentially and in accordance with the law.

Keep in mind that data transmission on the Internet can generally be subject to security vulnerabilities. Full protection against access by strangers is not possible

Access Data

The website operator or website provider collects data about accesses to the site and saves these as „server log files“. The following data will be collected:

- Visited website
- Time of access
- Amount of data sent in bytes
- Source/reference from which you came to this homepage
- Browser
- Operating system
- IP-Address

The collected data are for statistical purposes only and to improve the website. However the website operator reserves the right to retrospectively check the server logfiles in case of a concrete evidence point of an unlawful use.

Handling of personal data

The website operator collects, uses and transfers your personal data only if this is permitted by law or if you consent to the collection of data.

Personal information means all information that is used to identify your person and which can be traced back to you – such as your name, e-mail address and telephone number.

Handling of contact informations

If you contact the website operator through the offered contact options, your details will be stored so that they can be used to process and answer your request. Without your consent, this data will not be disclosed to third parties.

Rights of the user: information, correction and deletion

As a user, you will receive, at the request of you, free information about which personal data has been stored about you. If your request does not conflict with a legal obligation to retain data (eg data retention), you are entitled to correct incorrect data and to block or delete your personal data.
